60103	A Nurse's Guide to Discharge Planning	The purpose of this course is to inform nurses about the discharge planning process so that they will provide effective discharge planning for their patients.
CE436	A Valid, Reliable Triage System Can Help You Better Assess ED Patients' Acuity	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with an understanding of the history, types, and methods of ED triage, with an emphasis on the five-level triage systems.
CE601	Adult Obesity in the United States	The goal of this program is to familiarize nurses with the growing epidemic of obesity among adults in the United States.
CE491	Aspiration: Preventing a Deadly Complication in Vulnerable Populations	The purpose of this module is to educate nurses about how to identify patients at high risk for aspiration and how to protect patients from aspirating.
CE463	Attn Nurses! Anticoagulation Overdoses Prompt Joint Commission to Issue New Safety Requirement	The goal of this program is to inform nurses of current care practices for hospitalized patients on anticoagulation therapy.
CE156	Brain Attack Part 1: Diagnostic Studies	The goal of this program is to enhance nurses' ability to recognize, evaluate, and intervene on behalf of patients who may be having a brain attack.
CE157	Brain Attack Part 2: Administering a Thrombolytic Agent	The goal of this program is to enhance nurses' ability to administer thrombolytic agents and care for patients who have had an ischemic brain attack.
CE337	Cholesterol: The Good, the Bad, and the Balanced Part 1: Assessment	The goal of this program is to inform nurses about the global risk assessment for cardiovascular disease (CVD) associated with lipid profile values and the therapeutic lifestyle changes recommended to reduce risk.
CE338	Cholesterol: The Good, the Bad, and the Balanced Part 2: Assessment	The goal of this program is to inform nurses about the medications used to treat patients with hyperlipidemia who are at significant risk for cardiovascular disease (CVD).
CE367-60	Clearing Up the Confusion About Delirium	The goal of this delirium continuing education program is to inform nurses about the characteristics of delirium, conditions under which delirium may occur, and nursing actions that are indicated.
CE196-60	Control of the Hypertension: Can We Win the War?	The goal of this program is to update nurses' ability to identify and treat people with hypertension.

CE310	Dizziness in Elders (Defined and Differentiated)	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with practical guidelines for assessing and managing the care of elders who experience dizziness.
PT12	Exercise and Fall Prevention in Seniors	This is a Physical Therapy module not specified as RN. The goal of this program is to familiarize physical therapists with how exercise positively improves a senior's balance, reaction time, functional ability, and risk for falls in both community and institutional settings.
CE251-60	Exercise for Health and Fitness	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with current physical activity/exercise guidelines for healthy adults.
CE151-60	Fall Prevention Among the Elderly	The goal of this program is to improve clinicians' ability to identify and minimize risk factors for falls in the elderly and understand the applicability of The Joint Commission's National Patient Safety Goal of reducing the risk of patient harm resulting from falls.
CE268	Family Caregivers: Doing Double Duty	The goal of this program is to help nurses understand the effect of providing care on the family caregiver and in particular, the employed family caregiver.
CE633	Happiness	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about the science of happiness, including evidence-based strategies for improving well-being.
CE559	HCAHPS Is All About Patient Satisfaction	The goal of this program is to provide information about the benefits of patient satisfaction surveys, specifically the Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems.
CE366	Hidden Danger-Venous Thromboembolism	The purpose of this program is to provide nurses with information about the risk factors for venous thromboembolism, its diagnosis, prevention, and treatment, and the potential for life-threatening complications.
CE312-60	Hospice and Palliative Care: Right Patient, Right Time, Right Place	The goal of this continuing education program is to provide useful, practical information about hospice and palliative care that will assist nurses in all settings to determine which patients will benefit from and are eligible for either hospice or palliative care.
CE506	Hypertension: Review of Guidelines and Drug Therapy Management	The purpose of this program is to inform nurses about current guidelines and drug therapy for the management of hypertension.
CE610	Interventional Rescue for Stroke	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about interventional radiology procedures that provide treatment options for acute ischemic stroke.
CE640	Interventional Rescue for Stroke	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about interventional radiology procedures that provide treatment options for acute ischemic stroke.

60074	Management of the Patient with Stroke	The purpose of this course is to provide nurses with information about stroke prevention and outline nursing care for the acute and rehabilitative care of a patient with a stroke.
CE291	Neuroprotection	The goal of this program is to update nurses' knowledge about neuroprotection, and its implications for stroke, subarachnoid hemorrhage (SAH), and brain and spinal cord trauma.
CE457	Nurses can be "Diabetes Detectives"	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with strategies to detect common, yet often underdiagnosed, complications associated with hyperglycemia and diabetes.
CE214-60	Polypharmacy in the Elderly	The goal of this program is to update nurses' ability to recognize and prevent problems of polypharmacy in the elderly.
CE615	Primary Stroke Center	The goal of this program is to familiarize nurses with certification standards and compliance requirements of an accredited primary stroke center.
CE606	Pulmonary Embolism: Small but Deadly Blockage	The purpose of this program is to review causes, symptoms, treatment and prevention of pulmonary emboli.
CE635	Shared Governance	The goal of this program is help nurses better understand shared governance and how to implement a successful program.
CE207-60	Smoking Cessation: Developing a Workable Program	The goal of this program is to assist healthcare providers in devising a plan to help patients quit smoking.
CE461	Stroke Alert, Think TPA!	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about the etiology, risk factors, signs and symptoms, and pharmacologic management of acute ischemic stroke, including stroke complicating cardiac catheterization.
CE591	Stroke Alert: A Neurological Emergency	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with knowledge about how to quickly recognize and manage adult patients with signs and symptoms of acute stroke.
CE540	Stroke: Providing the Best Care from the ED to Rehab	The purpose of this module is to provide an understanding of stroke, its treatment, and nursing actions to increase public awareness to prevent stroke.
60042	The ABCs of Blockers (The Antihypertensive Agents)	The goal of this program is to increase nurses' knowledge about four types of medications used to treat hypertension and improve cardiovascular and cerebrovascular health, and improve understanding of nursing implications associated with these medications.
CE626	The Healthcare Reform Act	The goal of this healthcare reform law continuing education program is to help nurses understand healthcare reform and be informed participants in its implementation.

CE533	The Hospitalized Older Adult Entering a Danger Zone	The purpose of this program is to provide nurses with information about the risks elderly adults face when they are admitted to an acute care hospital and the role that nurses have in reducing those risks.
CE292-60	The Nursing Role in Stroke Clinical Trials	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with an overview of the new-drug approval process and the potential nursing roles in stroke clinical trials for investigational drugs.
CE98-60	The Two Sides of Stroke	The goal of this program is to help nurses differentiate between the identification, treatment, and nursing care of patients with left- and right-sided strokes.
CE571	Traumatic Brain Injury	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about traumatic brain injuries, including epidemiology, types of injuries, signs and symptoms, and nursing assessment, interventions, and evaluation.
CE501	Uncovering Depression	The purpose of this module is to provide nurses with up-to-date information on depression and anxiety, particularly screening, diagnosis, treatment, and compliance concerns.
CE558	Under Pressure: Cerebral Aneurysm	The goal of this program is to educate nurses about the incidence, etiology, signs and symptoms, complications, treatment, and nursing care associated with cerebral aneurysm.
CE206	Warfarin Basics	The goal of this program is to educate healthcare professionals about the care of patients receiving Warfarin therapy.
CE408-60	Weathering the Electrical Storm of AF	The goal of this program is to provide nurses with information about the incidence, etiology, pathophysiology, diagnosis, and management of atrial fibrillation.
CE585	Weight Management	The goal of this program is to empower nurses to help patients evaluate dietary recommendations and to make lifestyle changes to better manage their weight.
CE60098	Women and Heart Disease	The purpose of this home study course is to provide nurses with important information about the incidence of heart disease in women, its etiology and risk factors.
