What are the advantages of online learning?

- ⌘ It offers flexibility in that coursework can be done any time and any place the student has access to an online computer.
- ⌘ For students who enjoy reading, writing, and analyzing, it offers a stimulating environment.
- ⌘ It offers the opportunity to learn independently.
- ⌘ It offers the opportunity to enhance computer and written communication skills.
- ⌘ It helps the student experience a learning situation that is more similar to the working world of managing projects, being self-directed in completing assignments and communicating responsibly.

What are the challenges of online learning?

- ⌘ It requires personal responsibility, discipline and organization to complete the assignments as required.
- ⌘ It will likely be more time-consuming because it requires reading and typing which are more labor-intensive than listening and talking. The College estimates that time spent in *online discussion* will take 50% longer than in-class discussion.
- ⌘ Except for the math course, most of the learning and assessment is focused on reading and writing skills so this is a challenge for students who struggle in these areas
- ⌘ Students with weak computer skills or slow internet connections are likely to become frustrated.

What is an accelerated/blended course?

- ⌘ Accelerated courses incorporate into five (or eight, depending on the course) weeks what is normally covered in 15 weeks. This is accomplished by combining four hours of class once a week with a significant amount of online content.
- ⌘ The advantages and challenges of online learning should be reviewed prior to registering for accelerated/blended courses.
- ⌘ Students with weak computer skills are encouraged to take CMP101 Introduction to Computers to develop the skills needed for accelerated/blended courses.
